Special Meeting

The Farmland Town Council met on Monday, November 14, 2022, at 10:35 pm, in the council room at 104 E Henry Street for a Special Meeting. Those present were Steve Hernaly, Jim Main, Stephen Conner, and Marcy Yuknavage.

The meeting is to discuss employee compensation (salaries). Marcy told the Board what each employee makes per hour and her salary. Stephen asked Marcy how much money she put in the budget for raises. Marcy told him that she allowed a \$2000 dollar a year per person which would be \$0.96 per hour. Marcy told the Board that historically the Board has given \$0.50 per hour per person. Jim said he feels that everyone should receive the same amount, he does not believe in a percentage raise. The Board feels that \$2000 for each employee would be good. Steve said that he feels that the town has a great group of employees that work really well together and deserve to make more money. Marcy told the Board that she added \$500 more to each Board members salary because of request made at budget time. Stephen motioned to give each full-time employee a \$2000 dollar raise per year. Jim 2nd. All Ayes. Marcy clarified with the board to make sure her salary was included. Marcy explained that she has a salary position that can never go down in pay. Stephen motioned to include Marcy for the \$2000 per year raise. Jim 2nd. All Ayes. Stephen motioned to raise the town board salaries from \$3500 per year to \$4000. Jim 2nd. All Ayes

Jim asked if we had money in the budget to have hooded sweatshirts made for each town employee. Marcy said that she would have to check to see if she is able to do that from appropriated money.

Steve asked if we would send a weed notice to the Jackson Street property. Stephen would also like Melvin to check out Franks property for junk and weeds. Marcy said that she received a call concerning the burnt building at the end of East Henry Street and about Michael Mullens property with all the junk. Marcy said that she would add these request to the December meeting.
